

Linearised tables

Linearisable tables should be capable of being meaningful when read out loud from left to right.

Example of non-linearisable table

Name	Joe Bloggs	Asif Akbar	Phoolan Singh
Tel	4321	4567	5678
Fax	4322	4566	5677
Email	J.Bloggs@bath.ac.uk	A.Akbar@bath.ac.uk	P.Singh@bath.ac.uk

Example of linearisable table

Name	Tel	Fax	Email
Joe Bloggs	4321	4322	J.Bloggs@bath.ac.uk
Asif Akbar	4567	4566	A.Akbar@bath.ac.uk
Phoolan Singh	5678	5677	P.Singh@bath.ac.uk

BUT for a single person's entry (say where you have drilled down):
