Activities & Resources

Moodle can support the learning and teaching experience through the provision of a wide range of tools. These facilitate resource delivery and access to a range of online activities and (where used appropriately), can help the Moodle Teacher to construct an exciting and dynamic learning environment for their students.

As a general rule, it is not necessary to know what each resource or activity setting does, however most settings in Moodle will be accompanied by a help icon . Clicking on the help icon will open up context sensitive assistance which may be useful for those wishing to explore additional settings.

Resources

Anyone with Teacher permissions to a Moodle course will be able to upload content to it. Content commonly ranges from documents and web links, through to audio or visual materials.

- Uploading Files instructions on how to upload (and deleted uploaded) files
- Working with Folders learn how to create and organise folders
- · Linking to external websites create and display links to internal and external websites
- · Embedding content from non-secure sites

Activities

Prior to exploring the Activities and Resources below, you may wish to consider how to use the Activity Chooser.

Assignment - Used to submit files for marking. Integrated with the Turnitin plagiarism detection service.

Book - Makes it easy to create multi-page resources with a book-like format. moodle

Chat - A synchronous chat tool useful for small group work. moodle

Choice - Similar to a poll. Often used to enable students to select seminar groups etc. moodle

Database - Enables data to be input (by either Teachers or Students) and stored in a searchable format. moodle

Forum - An asynchronous discussion tool. moodle

Glossary - List of definitions – can be populated by either Teacher or Students. moodle

Lesson - Produces structured yet flexible learning paths. moodle

Moodle course. **moodle**Wiki - A series of web pages that can be edited by anyone. Useful for group projects. **moodle**

Quiz - Online quiz tool that can automatically provide marks and

SCORM package - Enables SCORM packages to be uploaded to a

Workshop - Facilitates peer and self assessment. moodle
