

Using Freewire to phone to and from PCs

The freewire telephone system can talk to the University telephone system over any Internet connection. They have a software downloadable client:

*You can dial **any** freewire ID from a University extension by prefixing the freewire ID with 1795.*

*You can dial **any** University extension from a freewire phone (hard or soft) by prefixing the extension with 2037.*

The freewire ID is a ~10 digit number you get assigned when you set up a user account. It's also the number that appears on a hardware handset when you're being phoned by a software handset.
