

# Getting started with Grunt

Don't know how to use [Grunt](#)? Find out here!

## Step-by-step guide

### Install grunt

```
$ sudo npm install -g grunt-cli
```

### Initialise package.json

```
$ npm init
```

### Install grunt task runner

```
$ npm install grunt --save-dev
```

### Create a Gruntfile.js containing this

#### Gruntfile.js

```
module.exports = function(grunt) {  
  grunt.initConfig({  
  
  });  
}
```

### Install load-grunt-tasks

```
$ npm install load-grunt-tasks --save-dev
```

### Add the config to Gruntfile.js

#### load-grunt-tasks

```
module.exports = function(grunt) {  
  require('load-grunt-tasks')(grunt);  
  grunt.initConfig({  
    ...  
  });  
}
```

You are now good to go, adding plugins for the tasks you might need! Here are two to start you off:
